Work should be submitted on A4 paper, neatly handwritten or typed and double spaced. Spell check may be used and young entrants may receive assistance with spelling and setting out.

Entrants are not required to perform their work. Submissions will be returned at the presentation, or by mail if entry is accompanied by a stamped, self addressed envelope.

*(Envelope must be of appropriate size to fit work being returned).*

Entrants names and details should be recorded on the entry form but **SHOULD NOT APPEAR ANYWHERE ON THE WRITTEN WORK.**
